

How can you help prevent falls?

Slips, trips and falls are a leading cause of workplace injury and death:

227,760 injuries and 887 deaths annually







Don't be complacent when it comes to fall hazards.

- · Be aware of your environment
- Avoid distractions
- · Keep work areas clean
- Take your time and don't rush especially around corners and doorways
- · Wear the proper personal protective equipment
- · Choose the right footwear for your work

- · Use the correct ladder or scaffolding for the job
- · Always hold the handrail when using the stairs
- Never carry too much in your hands or anything that obstructs your view
- · Watch where you are going
- · Keep an eye out for changes in elevation
- · Report any fall hazards you find



3rd leading cause of work-related injuries

- Injury rate: 23.1 per 10,000 full-time workers
- · Age group most at risk: 55 and over
- Industries most at risk: transportation and warehousing and agriculture
- Typical days lost: 12
- Most frequent **type of injury**: sprains, strains, tears
